





## Young adults are found in many places

- 71% of young adults live with a parent (July 2020, ages 18-24)
- 41% of young adults are enrolled in either a 2- or 4-year college (2019, ages 18-24)
- 69% of young adults are in the work force (2020, ages 20-24)
- 27% of young adults are "disconnected" neither enrolled in school nor working (July 2020, ages 20-24)

# Young Adults & COVID: Most Cases, Fewest Deaths

#### Young adults, ages 18-29, as of 10/13/2021

- Cases:
  - 7.7 million cases of COVID-19 among young adults, more than any adult age group, accounting for 22% of all cases in the US.
- Deaths:
  - 3,804 COVID-19 deaths among young adults, the lowest of any adult age group, less than 1% of all deaths.

## **Young Adults & COVID-19 Vaccines**

- Young adults, ages 18-24, as of 10/17/21
  - 65% of have received at least <u>one vaccine</u>, up from 33% at the end of April.
  - 54% have been <u>fully vaccinated</u>, up from 17% at the end of April.
  - These are the <u>lowest rates</u> among any adult age group.


